Year 7-10 PAT-Reading Comprehension Assessment

During Week 9 Term 1 students in Years 7, 8, 9, and 10 will be participating in the PAT-Reading Comprehension assessment.

This assessment is part of a program of ongoing evaluation of student skills and abilities in reading comprehension. The results from these assessments are used by the College to identify student strengths and areas of need as well as monitoring student progress.
