

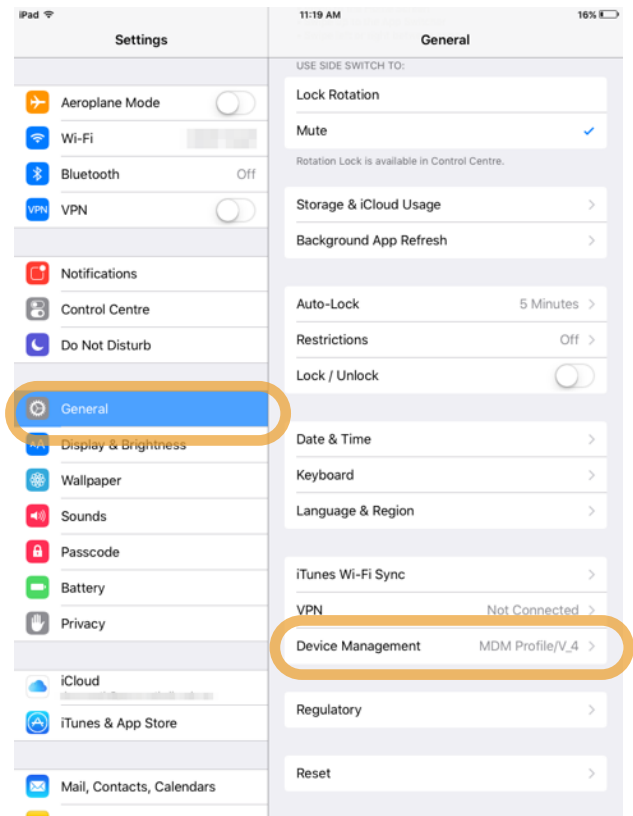
Unenrolling your iPad from Airwatch

Unenrolling (or disconnecting) your iPad (or other iOS device) from Airwatch is easy. Remember that doing this will remove all the settings that Airwatch is providing to your device, so you will lose your college network connection when you do this.

All of the following steps **should be done while you are connected to the internet** via wifi, whether at home or somewhere else.

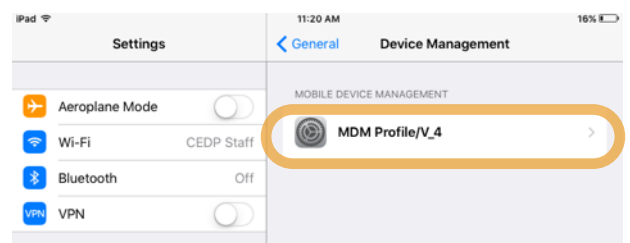
First, open your Settings on your iPad, and tap on "General" in the left hand pane.

In the right hand pane, scroll down to and tap on "Device Management".



In the right hand pane you should now see an entry for the settings that Airwatch is providing to your device (an example of what this can look like is shown on the right).

Tap on "**MDM Profile**" or "**Workspace Services**". The profile may be named either or end in a different number than what is shown.



When the profile opens in the right hand, tap on "Remove Management" and if it asks for a passcode enter your iPad's passcode (what you enter to wake your iPad up after it's gone to sleep).

It may take a minute or even up to five minutes for all the settings to be removed, so be patient.

Your device should now no longer be in communication with the college's Airwatch service.
